LANDFALL FOUNDATION AWARDS 37 GRANTS TOTALING \$60,458

WILMINGTON, NC - The Landfall Foundation today presented checks to 37 agencies to fund projects in the greater Wilmington area totaling \$60,458. In its fifth year of making grants, the Foundation was able to substantially exceed the \$35,016 made in grants to 22 projects in 2000.

The charitable foundation was formed in 1996 to establish a community support effort specifically originating from the residents of Landfall. It allocates funds targeted to health and welfare activities, education, and the arts and gives priority to organizations with low administrative overhead and high volunteer participation.
